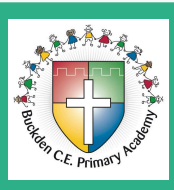




YEAR 3

we will collect data and use a software program to display this data.

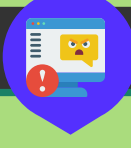
In Maths...

Make sure you have your PE kits on Tuesdays (outside cricket) and Fridays (inside dance).

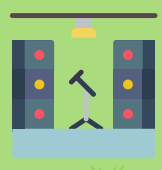
